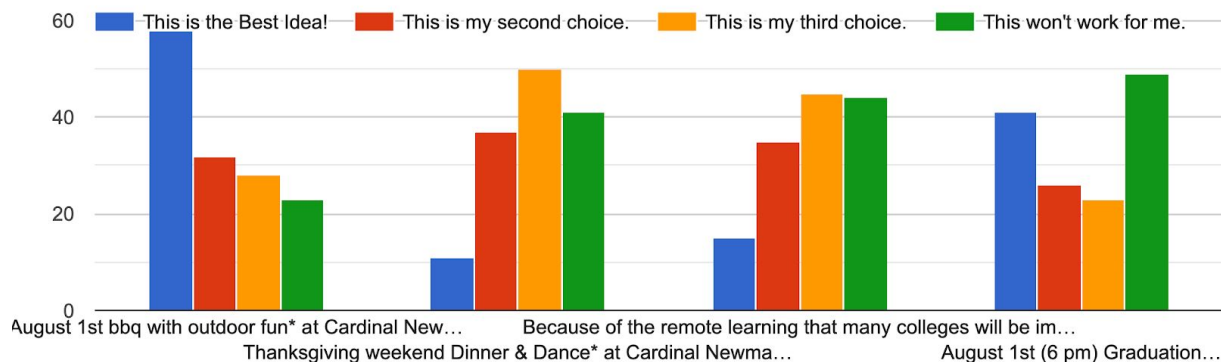


Class of 2020 Event Committee
